Subject Overview: Happy 2020! Since 2019 has come to a close, it is time to recap the authority-wide safety performance for the year. Overall, we have recorded a 2% increase in recordable injuries, a 23% increase in lost time injuries, and 5% increase in lost work days in comparison to 2018. As you may recall, 2018 was a tough year to top, as we celebrated the best safety record in NFTA history. While we remained close in 2019, there is still room for improvement this year. Keep up the great work!
